### JUNE

I have been looking ahead at the plan for The Bible in a Year. When we come to the minor prophets we are only looking at Jonah and so I thought it would be good to look at three of the others in the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> weeks of June to see what they have to say to us today. I am beginning with Joel. It would be good if you could read the whole of this short book before we “meet.” This material is for 11<sup>th</sup> June.

### **Week 2 – Dreams and Visions**

#### **Leader:**

Taste and see how gracious the Lord is: blessed are all those who put their trust in him.

#### **OPENING RESPONSES – based on Psalm 65**

O God it is right for us to praise you:

**YOU ARE THE ONE WHO ANSWERS OUR PRAYERS.**

You care for the land and water it:

**YOU MAKE IT RICH AND FERTILE**

You fill the running streams with water:

**YOU IRRIGATE THE LAND.**

You soften the ground with showers:

**YOU MAKE THE YOUNG CROPS GROW.**

You crown the year with your goodness:

**YOU GIVE US A PLENTIFUL HARVEST.**

The pastures are filled with flocks:

**THE HILLSIDES ARE CLOTHED WITH JOY.**

The fields are covered with grain:

**THEY SHOUT FOR JOY AND SING.**

**Hymn or song:** singing is a bit challenging by zoom! You might like to read the words of Hymn 153: "Great is thy faithfulness."

**Read** Psalm 27

**Read:** Joel 2 verses 23 – 32

Mark 13 verses 24 - 27

### **Reflection**

Reflect for 5 – 7 minutes.

The Covid 19 pandemic has caused many people to think in different ways. Some of that is because we have had to act in different ways and that is certainly true of the Church. You might want to consider what dreams and/or visions you have for yourselves as we go forward and also what dreams/visions you have for the life of the Church. Are there things to learn from lockdown experiences and practices to help us fulfil those dreams and visions? That is only one suggestion of how to look at Joel. You will have lots of other ideas.

This part of the service might involve music or a short drama; it might involve the use of “props” or something else visual; it might involve silence.
